Principal's Report

Education Week

The events during Education Week were an outstanding showcase of Lane Cove Public School and Public Education, clearly reflecting our School Plan's 3 Strategic Directions:

On Monday, as reported last week, we had an inspiring and entertaining performance from Christine Anu as part of our NAIDOC Week celebrations. We were also privileged to be joined by members of our local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community. Thanks to Ms Myors and her committee for organising this.

On Tuesday the Year 5 Choir performed at Sydney Town Hall as part of the Arts Alive Primary Choral Concert. The students performed beautifully and enjoyed being able to perform in such a significant venue. I thank Ms Todaro and Ms Di Maria for all of their work with the Year 5 Choir and for accompanying the students on the night.



On Wednesday we had 91 students perform in the Wakakirri dance performance at NIDA. This was a wonderful team effort by the students, teachers and parents involved. The performance itself was outstanding, full of colour, energy and positivity. The Wakakirri team won 2 awards on the night for best interpretation of the theme (fly), and most original use of materials for costumes. Thank you to Ms Dreverman and her team of teachers and parent volunteers for providing such a rich and rewarding experience for so many of our students.

Thursday was our Open/Grandparents Day. It was lovely to see so many parents, grandparents and friends come to the school to spend some time in the classroom with our students. Times like this are so beneficial to the students because it demonstrates to them that what they do here at school is valued by those around them. A very successful book stall, a terrific music concert and a delicious morning tea was enjoyed by all. My thanks to all of the Kindergarten parents, coordinated by Jennifer Perez for assisting and providing the morning tea.

The day concluded with our STEAM Twilight sessions. Through their STEAM lessons during last term Year 1 and 2 classes created light installations, becoming a stunning display of lights in the library which would have made the producers of Vivid envious. Year 3 and 4 had a Future Transport Expo where people were able to try out and give feedback on the transport prototypes created by the students. There was great interest in both displays which highlights the enormous support we get from the school community and which shows the students how much their work is valued. I would like to thank all the teachers involved in bringing these displays to life, in particular Ms Dreverman and the STEAM team.

School Crossing Supervisors – Work with your community 1 x Casual Position – Lane Cove Local Government Area (00006E4P)

An important person in a child's school life is the School Crossing Supervisor, who ensures they cross the road safely. The role requires minimal hours out of your day and gives something worthwhile back to the community.

The hours are usually 8.00am to 9.30am and/or 2.30 to 4.00pm Monday to Friday during school terms. The base rate is \$23.02 - \$27.62 per hour.

All the qualifications you need are community spirit, good communication skills, an alert and professional attitude to work and a reliable personality. The casual hours and school holidays would suit a parent or grandparent, a retiree or anyone wanting meaningful work — but not full-time.

Training for your key responsibilities of directing traffic to stop at the designated crossing and giving clear instructions to infants and primary school students to cross the road safely, will be provided. You may be required to attend a health assessment. Appointment is subject to a Working with Children Check clearance.
